Proposal to establish Hydro Electric Station in Bulung'ur district

Existing potential of the territory

Available Benefits

The Zarafshan river enters from the southern part of the district through the Republic of Tajikistan. The Zarafshan river crosses 15 km of the district. In addition, there is a Tuyatortar canal with a width of 20 meters and a depth of 2,5-4,5 meters. The water capacity of the channel is 45 m3 cubic/second. On the banks of this channel, there are favorable conditions and opportunities for micro-hydrogen installation. Consumer households and

In addition, it is possible to sign a sales contract for the direct sale of generated electricity to individuals and legal entities without connecting to a single electric energy system, through the construction of a local network.

According to the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated February 16, 2023 "On measures to accelerate the introduction of renewable energy sources and energy-saving technologies in 2023" No. PQ-57 starting from April 1, 2023, individuals and legal entities that have installed renewable energy sources devices with a total capacity of up to 100 kW will receive property tax on these devices, land tax on the plots occupied by the devices, and the profit received by legal entities for electricity sold to the public grid. they are exempt from paying tax for a period of three years from the moment they are put into use, and for a period of ten years if they are installed with an electric energy storage system with a capacity of not less than 25% of the capacity of the installed solar panels.


Establishment of logistics center in Bulung'ur district

Existing potential of the territory

The total area of Bulung'ur district is 0.76 thousand square kilometers, and as of October 1, 2023, 200.6 thousand people live here.

The district is located in the center of the Republic, and the M-39 highway of international importance and the railway (24 km) pass through the district, and it is 32 km from the center of the district to the Samarkand International Airport. 55 500 vehicles pass through the district M-39 international highway a day. Of these, 46 000 cars and 7 000 trucks, 2 500 buses.

In general, the geographical location of our district is a convenient opportunity for the establishment of a modern logistics center, it provides an opportunity to reduce costs related to the transportation of goods and effectively organize the logistics of production and trading companies.



Possibilities of growing and processing potatoes

Existing potential of the territory

Potatoes are considered the main raw material for obtaining food, as well as starch, alcohol, glucose, dextrin and other products. In particular, more than 15 of its species are widespread in Uzbekistan.

Vegetation period is 70-130 days. Depending on the ripening period, potatoes are divided into early ripening varieties of 70-80 days, medium ripening varieties of 90-100 days and late ripening varieties of 120-130 days.

- The Arizona variety is suitable for the climate of the district, medium ripening and yields up to 600 centners.

- Santo, Evolution varieties - suitable for the district climate, early ripening.

- Picasso, Esmi varieties - suitable for the climate of the district, medium ripe Yields up to 600 centners. The total irrigated cropland in Bulungur district is 15 637 hectares, on average 5 200 hectares of spring potatoes and 3 500 hectares of winter potatoes are planted every year. Arizona, Evolution, Picasso, Sante, Esmi, Savyolla and other varieties of potatoes are grown in the district. The positive aspect of these varieties is that they are suitable for the soil and climate conditions of the district and are highly productive.

The average yield is 300-600 centners per year 160-180 thousand tons are harvested. This region makes up 55-60% of the total potato harvest.

10.6 thousand tons of the total harvest is used for domestic needs, 5.9 percent. The remaining 94.1 percent of the products were sold to other regions.

The above figures confirm that Bulungur district is the most favorable area for potato processing.

Cultivation of cocoons

Existing potential of the territory

Available Benefits

Uzbekistan is a country with rich experience and high potential in the field of silk production. The fact that the ancient technology of making Uzbek silk fabrics - satin and adras - was included in the list of protection of intangible cultural heritage by UNESCO is a practical confirmation of this, a high recognition of the world community.

The possibilities of silk production in Bulung'ur district are very wide, today there are 888 hectares of mulberry fields, and in 2023, 115 tons of products will be grown. The raw materials of cocoons grown in the district are received and exported by the limited liability company "ZAR OLTIN PILLA" located in Amir Temur neighborhood.

The enterprise is located next to the "Amir temur" small industrial zone and is 0.8 km from the international highway. In this industrial zone, there is a possibility to implement the project of deep processing of silk and production of finished products. According to the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers No. 773 "On the procedure for allocating subsidies to cocoon growing individuals for the cocoon (wet cocoon) crop grown by them", cocoon growing individuals are given a number of benefits subsidy in the amount of 5 thousand soums per kilogram.

It is known from the world experience that cocoon cultivation is a specific type of activity, in which success depends on systematic implementation of the work. Because the main part of the income goes to those who produce finished products. For example, the price of one kilogram of silk in the world market is 38-40 US dollars. If it is made into a kalava, the price will increase to 55 dollars. If you weave cloth and sew clothes from it and sell it, the income will increase 3 times. However, from each kilogram of silk kalava, up to 11 meters of fabric is woven.

It is also beneficial to develop carpet making. For example, only 10 kilograms of silk thread is needed to weave one carpet. In this account, about 500-600 dollars will be spent on silk thread. When the carpet is ready, its price will increase 10 times.

In addition, a liter of silkworm oil is available in the world market Estimated around \$200.

Cultivation and processing of grapes in Bulung'ur district

Existing potential of the territory

The geographical location of Bulung'ur district, climatic conditions, active temperature of the sun, fertile irrigated lands and unique mountainous regions created the ground for the development of industrial-scale viticulture.

In the Bulungur district, the total cultivated area is 15,600 hectares, of which 5,246 hectares are grapes, so 56% of the area is planted with khoraki and kishbop grapes. The area of numbered grapes is 2308 hectares, or 44% of the total area of vineyards.

In the district, mainly black raisins, Rizamat ata, Mediny, varieties and industrial Kaberni, Saperavi, Boyan Shirey varieties are planted. The positive side of these industrial varieties is that they give an average yield of 300 centners per hectare and create a wide opportunity for the production of wine, brandy and brandy spirit.

On average, 65,000-75,000 tons of grapes are grown in the district per year, 10 percent of which are processed by existing enterprises in the district.

10,000 tons or 14% of the total harvest is directed to processing and domestic consumption. The remaining 86% of the products are sent to neighboring regions and exported.

Available Benefits

According to the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. 144 of March 1, 2022 on the development of irrigation systems in the field of agriculture, in case of introduction of drip irrigation systems, subsidy funds of 8.0 million soums will be allocated for each hectare of vineyard. In addition, according to relevant decisions, subsidy funds in the amount of 600 000 but not more than 120 million soums per 1 meter will be allocated for drilling an irrigation well.

In the years 2017-2022, 874 hectares of industrial vineyards were established as a result of the programs adopted for the development of industrial viticulture.

In addition, there are 2.2 thousand hectares of dry land in the district for the establishment of industrial grape plantations

Based on the above information, the establishment of a grape processing enterprise in the territory of "Urgut" free economic zone is considered a promising project. The fact that the population has extensive historical experience in growing grapes will not be a problem in terms of qualified employees when a grape processing enterprise is established in the future.

Establishment of a wind power plant in Bulung'ur district

Existing potential of the territory

Available Benefits

Bulung'ur district is located in the eastern part of Samarkand region, 700 meters above sea level. The average wind speed in the district during the year is 5-15 m/second.

There is constant wind throughout the year in the Gobdin massif of the district, and these areas are part of dry land areas. (high point)

This area is distinguished by the fact that the wind blows throughout the year, and from the logistical point of view, it is very easy to bring and install wind generators of any size on the international M39 highway and railway.

The main consumers of the produced electricity are high-rise residences in the New Uzbekistan massif built in the Gobdin massif, large poultry farms, "Urgut SEZ" with an area of 20 hectares, a small industrial zone, and existing production and service enterprises established in this area. The decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated September 9, 2022 "On additional measures for the introduction of energy-saving technologies and the development of small-capacity renewable energy sources" No. PF-220 a sales contract is signed for the guaranteed purchase of electricity for a period of not less than 15 years.
